Important Drill Notes for Parents:

- **Parents:** Pickup is 1500 / 3:00 p.m. sharp, please be respectful to our volunteers and do not be late!
- **Parents:** Cadets must bring a packed lunch.
- **Parents:** Please ensure your cadet is hydrated and eats a good meal prior to Muster.
- **Parents:** We intend to keep the cadets indoors for this drill, due to forecasted low temperatures.

Drill Notes:

- **Cadets:** NWU's Type III are expected to have **SLEEVES ROLLED DOWN** and **BOOTS SHINED**, inspection ready.
- **Cadets:** **Dress Whites / Salt and Peppers / Khakis** are expected to be on a hanger, contained within a bag/garment bag, and have **ALL RIBBONS / APPURTENANCES, BADGES, NAME TAGS, COVERS** and **SHOES SHINED; inspection ready.**

NOTE

You will NOT be changing into your dress uniform, but are expected to bring all pieces of the uniform for inspection.

- **Cadets:** Bring personal hydration and your Sea Cadet ID's
- **Cadets / Parents:** Any cadet arriving after 0900 will be considered tardy. Please plan to arrive between 0830 and 0845 to avoid being tardy.

Appearance / Uniform of the Day (UOD)

- All cadets will report in UOD and note any additional uniform changes for the drill - **BRING ALL ITEMS FROM YOUR UNIFORM TO DRILL.** Do not wait until the morning of drill to assemble your uniform.
- **Grooming Standards:** Males must have proper haircuts and clean-shaven face. Females-proper hair style/hair color.
- No unnatural hair color.

NOTE

If a cadet arrives not in a proper uniform and/or not in accordance with grooming standards, they will be sent home with the parent/guardian.

Attendance is Mandatory - You must attend 75% of all scheduled drills to remain a member of this unit. Valid reasons include illness, school/family/church obligations. You **MUST** submit a Leave of Absence form (found on website) to be excused. Absences regardless of reason, counts against the unit.
